Amelia Trust Farm supports teenagers in South Wales who are struggling in main stream education. Through spending time in our unique countryside environment, young people learn new skills, build their confidence, and develop better relationships with their peers, family, and friends.

There are 20 different species of animals at Amelia Trust, from fluffy rabbits to cheeky goats, and gorgeous donkeys to friendly pigs. The animals play a key role in our work with young people and are very popular with our visitors.

Amelia Trust receives no statutory funding, and it's through visitors, supporters, volunteers and those booking our facilities, that we are able to continue our life-changing work.

BUNKHOUSE OVERVIEW



Based close to Cardiff, Cowbridge, and Barry, the Bunkhouse is easily accessible off the M4



A large free car park on site is accessible for mini buses, large buses, and coaches



Onsite facilities that can be accessed for the duration of your stay include an outdoor park, cob oven and BBQ space, beautiful woodland, and of course, you'll be able to see the animals at our Care Farm



The Bunkhouse sleeps 30, has a large commercial kitchen, living space, and ample bathrooms

BUNKHOUSE FACILITIES



Bedrooms

- A ground floor leader's room that sleeps 3
- 2 ground floor bedrooms that sleep 5 and 3
- 3 first floor bedrooms that sleep 4, 7, and 8



Bathrooms

- Ground floor ensuite with toilet and shower (attached to leader's room)
- Ground floor disabled toilet and shower
- First floor bathroom with 2 toilets and 1 shower
- First floor bathroom with 3 toilets and 2 showers

Entrance porch for muddy wellies and wet coats

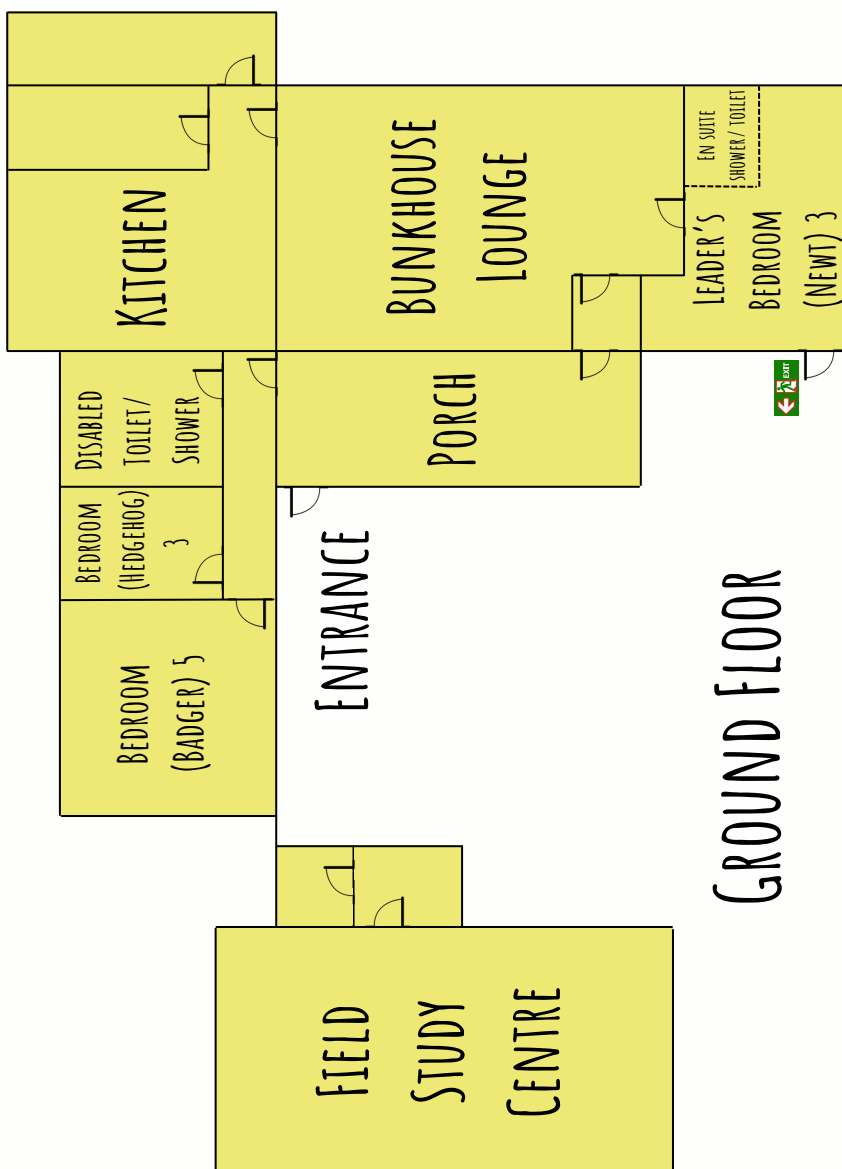
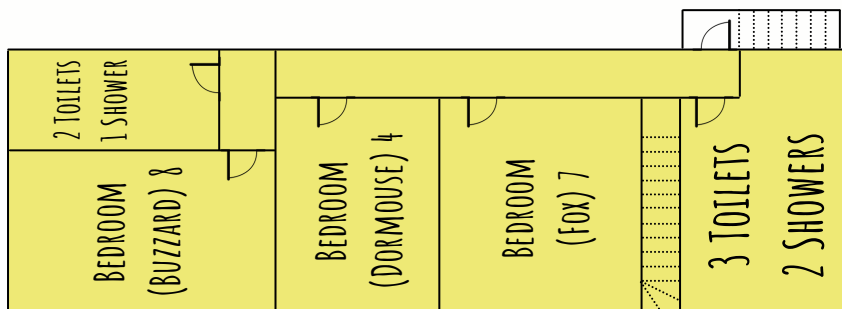

INSPIRATION

A typical two night stay at the Bunkhouse could look something like this...

Friday Evening

- Leaders arrive at Bunkhouse to be welcomed by our Site Manager, and receive a short health and safety reminder before the rest of your group arrives
- Evening food using the kitchen in the Bunkhouse
- Marshmallow toasting at the cob oven in the woodland followed by campfire songs

Saturday

- Rise and shine and enjoy preparing breakfast in the kitchen
- Explore Amelia Trust Farm! Get to know the animals on site, play in the park, and see if you can spot wildlife in the woods. Wander down to the pond, discover our Wildlife Trail through the trees, and have an outdoor adventure
- Lunch time BBQ at the cob oven
- Spend the afternoon playing games on the Cross Field, doing arts and crafts in the Field Study Centre, or relaxing in the Bunkhouse lounge
- Explore the Farm at dusk and see if you can spot bats in the woodland
